The Unique Boutique began as a clothing bank, in place to provide emergency clothing to those in need. After the Fredericton Food Bank's move to Greener Village, the clothing bank was reopened as a thrift boutique.

The boutique setting allows individuals to choose the clothing they want and aids in promoting dignity. All profits of the boutique go back into food centre operations.



Emergency Clothing

Clothing can be expensive, especially when it's already hard to make ends meet. Greener Village clients are able to access emergency clothing four times per year free of charge.



Donations

The Unique Boutique accepts new and used clothing, shoes, accessories, books, toys, and housewares. All items are cleaned and tested before sale and will be free of defects. We cannot accept furniture or technology at this time.



Pricing

Most items are priced between \$0.50 and \$10, although there are some specific items that may be marked higher (wedding dresses, some housewares). Our pricing aim is affordability over profit.



Volunteering

The Boutique is always looking for new faces! Volunteer positions include cashier, sorter, and assistant. Positions are available for varying shifts during the boutique's open hours.

Sorter: Sorting and inspecting new donations

Cashier: Ringing in merchandise and interacting with customers

Assistant: Helping the boutique manager with daily tasks.
