Community Garden Plots

Greener Village offers fifty individual garden plots for free use by our clients. We provide all tools, soil amendments, and instruction, and our clients keep all produce grown in the plot.

Production Greenhouses

Three large in-ground greenhouses serve as growing space for fresh, organic produce to supplement our food hampers. We grow over 20 varieties of vegetables and herbs for client use.



Education

We encourage guided tours for groups, including schools and community organizations. Greener Village is currently partnering with UNB Forestry to provide interactive learning for all age groups.



Mighty Monarchs

Greener Village is in partnership with Monarch Watch to help facilitate efforts to preserve the Monarch butterfly in Canada. Learn to raise and tag butterflies on one of our many workshop days in the summer!



Native Edibles

Our Native Edible Shrubs and Trees garden is an educational tool for local foragers and plant enthusiasts. The garden is home to over 20 species of edible plant species that can be found in NB.
